

Statement on REACH

Modiform attaches great importance to hygiene, quality and corporate social responsibility (CSR).

That is why these form part of the sustainable development of our processes, as stated in our mission. It goes without saying that we devote attention to this when further improving our products, developing new products, purchasing raw materials, and our logistics activities.

Continuous attention to taking care of people, protecting the environment, and ensuring hygiene is important in this regard. Where necessary, adjustments will be made to ensure the correct weighing up of interests. With regard to the purchasing of raw materials, we have to adhere to various EU directives and regulations.

EU Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)

REACH is a system for the registration, evaluation, and authorization of chemicals that are produced in or imported into the European Union. REACH is an acronym of Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and restriction of CHemicals.

As Modiform does not itself produce or import any chemical substances into the EU, the registration obligations under the REACH regulations are not directly applicable. Where necessary, we have informed our suppliers about REACH and asked them to comply with all the relevant obligations, including registration fees, arising from the regulations.

According to the migration tests performed, the products have been shown to meet the following requirements: the packaging does not contain more than 100 mg of heavy metals per kilogram.
